NEW BUSINESS:

- **Councilor Gregg** –
 - Asked Mary Lou Prudnick about three businesses not listed on the dumpster report.
 - Feels the Mayor does a great job in the community but makes poor financial decisions. Wants all of council to work together.
- **Councilor Luzader** –
 - Asked if there are any proposals currently in the works to assist with the current financial situation and get the town back on its feet.
 - Requested a work session with the Mayor, council, office staff, Chief Propst, and Public Works Director Nuce to determine how to spend our money wisely.
- **Councilor Brown**–
 - Motion to suspend the ability of the Mayor and Code Enforcement to sign permits without the approval of council. ***Note: this motion was improper and could not be voted upon as it was not on the agenda. As such, no action was taken.*

CITIZENS:

- **Tom Aglinsky, 512 Congress Ave**
 - Feels a state or independent auditor should be called in to do an audit of the town's debt
 - Feels the boat at the dock is taking up space and should be removed; can't fish from the dock; docks need railings
 - Stated cars are speeding on Fairfield Street and a police vehicle is needed in the area
- **James Gaston, 1388 Fenwick St**
 - Spoke about the boat at the dock
 - Feels council is not doing their job and is ashamed of the way meetings are conducted
- **Jeanette Marra, 429 Boyers Ave**
 - Asked if an additional speed hump could be installed near Guttman Oil to slow down the traffic
- **Jeanette Baniak, 443 Pleasant Hill Ave**
 - Agreed with Mrs. Marra about the speed hump


